

Child Protection Policy

Burrough Green Primary School operates the following policy on its website regarding the use of photographs, to ensure the privacy and safety of pupils at the school:

1. Where pupils are named, only their first names are given;
2. Where a pupil is named, no photograph of that pupil is displayed;
3. Where a photograph is used which shows a pupil, no name is displayed.

By observing these points, the school ensures that visitors to the website cannot link images of pupils to names of pupils. When choosing photographs for the website, the school is mindful of the way pupils may appear in them, and will not include images which may be considered inappropriate. The school follows a policy of seeking parents' permission before using images which show pupils on the website.

No other private information about pupils is ever published on the website such as surnames or contact details.

Online Safety in School

School uses a filtered internet feed from an education-accredited Internet Service Provider (ISP). In Cambridgeshire, this is via the Cambridgeshire Community Network (CCN). The internet feed for CCN schools is provided by our regional broadband consortium, E2BN, and web-filtering is achieved using the Protex system. This meets the Becta standards for accredited internet providers.

Protex categorises web sites in three ways:

- some URLs (addresses) are permanently blocked
- some are trusted - e.g. BBC and government sites – and this includes all files which can be downloaded from the site
- some are content-checked before being allowed

Staff who believe that an inappropriate item has passed through the filter can report it to the Schools ICT Helpline, by phone if the matter is urgent (0845 045 0973). Non-urgent queries can be sent to ict.helpline@cambridgeshire.gov.uk When Protex blocks web pages, an information page is displayed, and this includes a teacher's button enabling a comment or a request for unblocking to be submitted.
